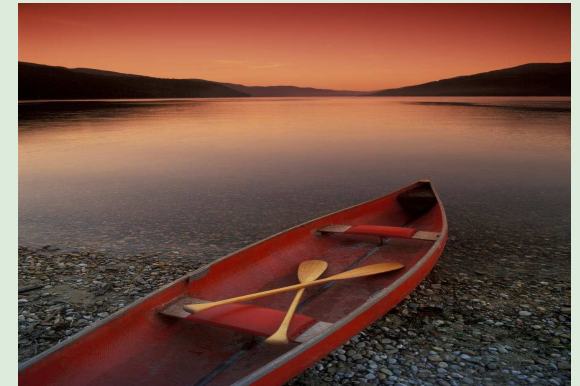

## Class Selections

8:45—10:00 a.m.

Archery: Try out your archery skills. Learn the basics to archery, such as different types of bows, equipment needed, and how to shoot.

Fly-fishing: Master basic fly casting techniques and learn about lines, knots, and fly selection. Participants will become familiar with the necessary equipment for fly-fishing and get to practice their new skills.

Turkey Call: Discover basic turkey calls to get the turkey to come to you. Whether you like hunting turkey or just want to get a close up look at them, this is a great class to find out how. Different types of turkey calls will be demonstrated.

Kayaking: Learn basic paddling strokes and boat control as well as safety on the water. You will have the time to try out your new skills on the lake. Please wear clothes that can get wet.

Canoeing: Learn the basic knowledge and skills needed to enjoy canoeing. Topics include safety, strokes, maneuvering, and more.

Campfire Cooking: Want to cook like a pro at your campsite? Take this class to discover how to make all sorts of food over the campfire. Different techniques will be discussed.

Colonial Candle Dipping: Find out how to make a candle like people did in colonial times. Make a candle to take home.

Fly-tying: Learn how to tie a fly to use for fly fishing, and discover which ones are best to use depending on the season.
